2018 M-ENABLING ROBOT OF THE YEAR AWARD GOES TO AVATARMIND FOR ITS IPAL ROBOT

BETHESDA, MD (May 21, 2018) – The organizers of the **M-Enabling Summit** are pleased to announce that its first “*M-Enabling Robot of the Year Award*” will be presented during a special on-stage introduction and robot demonstration on June 11, 2018.

The Award is designed to promote the awareness of the considerable potential benefits of robot applications for independent living, elderly care and special education, allowing outstanding pioneering innovators to share their latest breakthroughs.

The 2018 recipient of the M-Enabling Robot of the Year is the iPal Robot, selected for its features specifically developed for Special Education, Elderly Care and independent living for persons with disabilities. iPal operates with a friendly, non-threatening demeanor, supported by multiple sensors to assure safe human interactions. iPal has a conversational spoken language interface, facial expressions, full arm/hand movement, and can sense people’s mood. iPal is an open system based on the Android operating system with extensions for motion, sensor and natural language conversation allowing a wealth of third-party applications to be delivered on a robot.

Presenting the iPal Robot will be John S. Ostrem, Ph.D., CEO of AvatarMind, a company founded in 2014 by a group of entrepreneurs from Silicon Valley, PhDs from top universities, and robot experts from robotic companies. AvatarMind has an experienced research team with deep experience in artificial intelligence, motion control, sensors and power management technologies, all critical domains of innovation for the M-Enabling Ecosystem.

“This year presentation of the M-Enabling Robot of the Year will serve as a milestone in the evolution of our accessible and assistive technologies eco-system,” explained Axel Leblois, President of G3ict and M-Enabling Program co-chair. *“The iPal Robot is a great example of how leading edge enabling technologies are coming together in an affordable, versatile and open system platform which will foster multiple robotic innovations in support of persons with disabilities.”*
